1) Website -thoughts on new website and PPG section

Discussed adding the minutes of the PPG meetings to the website, Cranborne Practice have their minutes + action plan under their PPG section of the website. Adding a 'suggestions form' under the PPG section for patients to submit their thoughts for the PPG.

Add the action plan to the website, as well as the PPG Charter. Gill- add the link to the NHS Dorset PPG page.

Lynn- she didn't understand some of the abbreviations on the website, i.e., on Elisa's section 'LMC Representative', ENT, PCN etc.

GPs working days have since changed + needs to be updated.

Rosemary- useful to have photos of the Doctors/ Clinical staff on the website so that patients know who they are going to see.

Photos of the PCN staff, as well as admin/management team, not just the patient facing staff.

Previously not everyone wanted their photos visible online, but agreed that it should be 'all or nothing', i.e. every staff member has a photograph on the website or none. Photos on the screen in the waiting rooms, slideshow of staff- Julie Saunders is organising a slide show for the waiting room TV screen.

Elisa- 'usual GP system' that we have at the surgery

Discussed the reception team triaging patients before booking a doctor's appointment.

Lynn mentioned a personal experience where Susie from the reception team signposted her to the PCN Pharmacist Simon with her query, instead of booking an appointment with her GP.

Agreed that 'self-help' could be signposted better on the website.

Gill suggested a 'common ailments' section on the home page- or a 'How can we help you today' as taken from the Cranborne website

e.g. a 'Fast Track section' encouraging patients to help themselves instead of calling the surgery, including number for the Eye unit, Dorset MSK + other self-referral routes

Rosemary mentioned having a 'digital support session' at the surgery to help patients work SystmOnline + NHS App. Julie Saunders does run some sessions in Ferndown + could get involved, Patient Services Team at the surgery can get involved too.

Discussed E-Consult system, not available outside of surgery hours Rosemary mentioned 'Livi' for an alternative
